Our mission is to provide a counselling service sensitive to the needs of survivors of Sexual Violence, Rape, Childhood Sexual Abuse and Sexual Harassment, that is empowering, non-judgmental and consistent in approach that promotes the safety, privacy and dignity of the survivor. Services are available in Wexford, Enniscorthy, Gorey and New Ross.

Services include one to one counselling which is provided for women, men and adolescents who have been affected by any type of sexual violence (verbal or physical). Counselling is also provided for supporters of survivors of sexual violence (e.g. mother, sister, partner etc.)

Our counsellors are professionally qualified and accredited with recognized Accreditation Bodies.
